## General Terms and Conditions SoFestival

Version - 17 December 2022

Before registering you must read and accept our terms and conditions.

#### 1. Definitions

SoFestival is an event, hereafter called event, organized by student association (vereniging) SoSalsa, hereafter called SoSalsa. The event will be held from March 24° till March 26° 2023. These terms and conditions apply to all visitors of the event, hereafter named visitor.

### Privacy statement

SoSalsa obliges that visitor data will be only be used for the purposes of processing orders and marketing. The data will not be shared neither be sold to third parties.

## 3. Registration

Our site's registration system requires users to give us contact information and some more event specific information. The visitor's contact information is used to contact the visitor when necessary and inform him/her about the event. Event specific information is used in order to give the best possible experience to all visitors of the event. All information required should be truthfully answered and be up to date.

### 4. Booking and payment

To book a ticket, the visitor has to fill a registration form. After payment, the visitor will receive a booking confirmation via email. SoSalsa will be at liberty to refuse any booking for any reasons. Should this occur, the paid amount shall be refunded.

# 5. Cancellation and transfer of booking

Refund of a ticket in case of cancellation is not possible. Exceptions can be made under special circumstances, however SoSalsa is not obliged to.

Admission is personal; the transfer of a booking to a third person is only possible upon approval of SoSalsa, and payment of an administrative fee of  $\in$  10.

The event requires a minimum of visitors, set by SoSalsa. Should this minimum not be reached, SoSalsa can postpone or cancel the event. In case of cancellation all bookings will be refunded.

### 6. Admission & Check-in

The admission to the event is personal. At check-in, it is required to show a valid and clear photo identification (i.e. passport, ID or Student ID). Admittance to the event can be refused without photo identification.

Furthermore, in case the visitor has obtained a student discount during booking, the visitor is required to show a valid Student ID at the check-in of the event. A booking with student discount is invalid without Student ID, and will not be refunded.

A booking with SoSalsa membership discount will be internally checked and if possible corrected before the

event. It however stays the responsibility of the visitor and is considered invalid at the door without correction.

# 7. Film & Photography

Any filming or photographing during the event, other than for personal use, is not allowed. Furthermore, during the workshops filming or photographing is strictly forbidden. Individual instructors may choose to allow filming at the end of a workshop, which is up to their discretion. Any breach may result in the immediate exclusion of the offender without reimbursement of the visitor fee.

### 8. Damage responsibility

The visitor is responsible for any damages caused by his direct and indirect actions and is financially responsible. Damages include but is not limited to: the building/location, inventory, sound and light equipment or if SoSalsa or one of their sub-contractors is financially disadvantaged in any other way. SoSalsa has the right to solve any damages in reasonable way on costs of the visitor.

# 9. Liability and Agreement

SoSalsa shall not be liable of any kind. Liability is excluded in particular for personal injury, damage or loss of property or carried items. Upon booking - even when carried out by a third person - the visitor agrees to these terms and conditions, that at once take effect.

SoSalsa reserves the right to amend or change the rules, terms and conditions at any time.

These General Terms and Conditions shall be subject to and are construed in accordance with the laws of The Netherlands and the parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Dutch courts.

All disputes will be resolved by the competent court in the district in which SoSalsa is established.

#### 10. Event Rules

These event rules, and code of conduct, are set to provide the best experience for all our visitors and are to be followed strictly. In case of non-obeisance of one or more rules SoSalsa reserves the right to immediately exclude a visitor from the event without the rights to a refund.

- Any behavior not in accordance with the society Rules of Conduct (Society by laws and rules latest revision) at the discretion of SoSalsa, will lead to removal of the event without any refund.
- Respect every visitor as well as the properties of others. Amongst others take especially good care of respecting the personal space, beliefs and cultural differences of others. SoFestival aims for a good and fun atmosphere for everyone, so be open and accepting.

- Registration without a dance partner is possible.
  SoSalsa aims to get an equal number of male (leader) and female (follower) dancers. However, this cannot be guaranteed.
- Visitors need to be in time for the workshops. The venue opens 30 minutes prior to the first workshops. If you are not on time for a workshop, you may be declined to join the workshop, which is up to SoSalsa.
- Admission for parties after 24:00 is not possible.
- SoSalsa will shoot photos and film of the event.
  SoSalsa holds the right to publish any material online. If you do not want to appear in any of the photos or film footage send an email to SoSalsa.
- Mobile phones need to be muted or switched off during the workshops. When the instructors are talking, be quiet so everyone can follow along.
- Visitors should take good care of their own personal hygiene.
- Only refreshments purchased at the event location may be consumed on the premises. This excludes personal water bottles which may be brought to the workshops.
